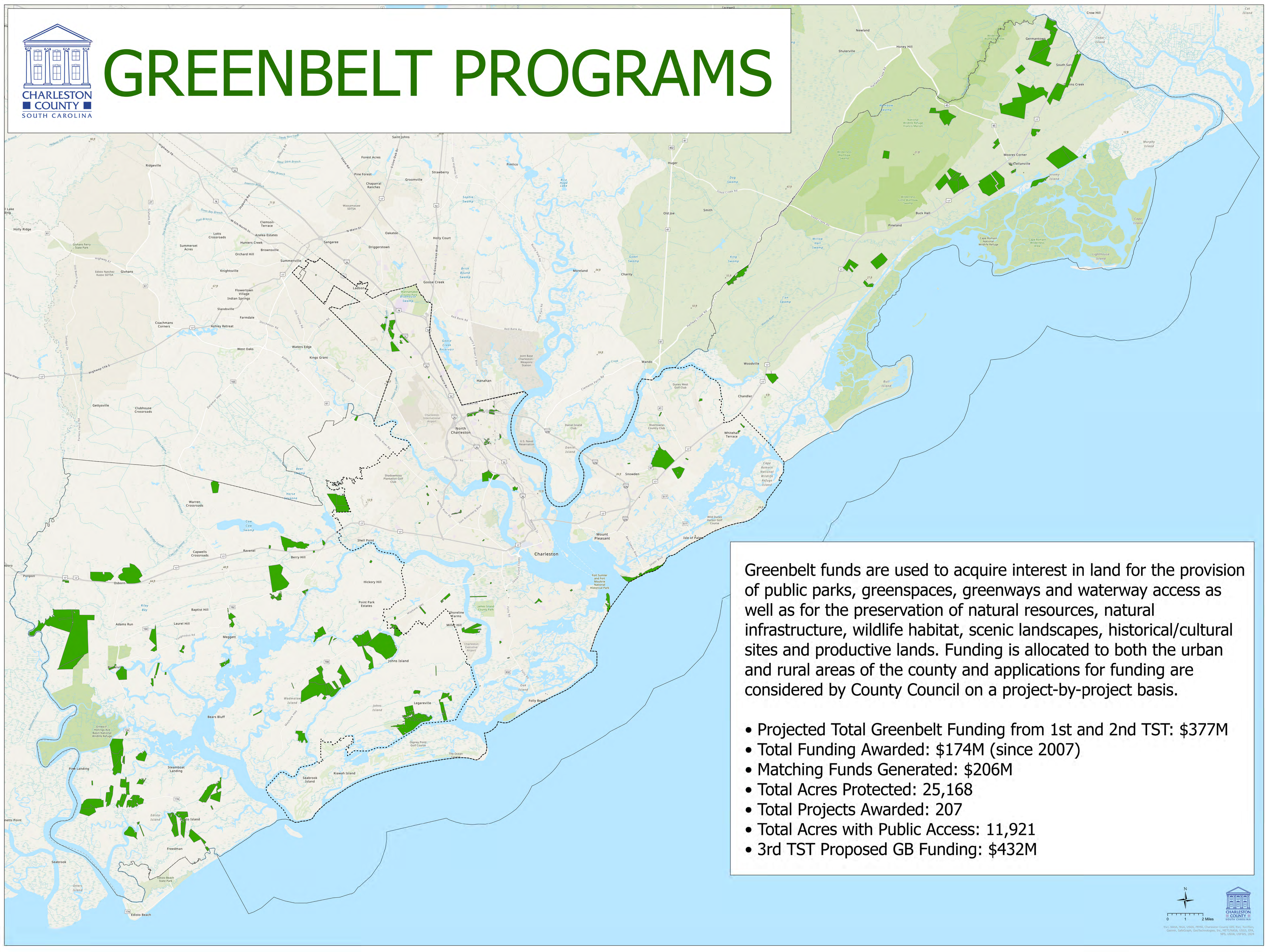




# GREENBELT PROGRAMS



Greenbelt funds are used to acquire interest in land for the provision of public parks, greenspaces, greenways and waterway access as well as for the preservation of natural resources, natural infrastructure, wildlife habitat, scenic landscapes, historical/cultural sites and productive lands. Funding is allocated to both the urban and rural areas of the county and applications for funding are considered by County Council on a project-by-project basis.

- Projected Total Greenbelt Funding from 1st and 2nd TST: \$377M
- Total Funding Awarded: \$174M (since 2007)
- Matching Funds Generated: \$206M
- Total Acres Protected: 25,168
- Total Projects Awarded: 207
- Total Acres with Public Access: 11,921
- 3rd TST Proposed GB Funding: \$432M
