



### Lowcountry Natural Resources

#### ACE Basin - Willtown (Knox)

- Conservation Easement
- Easement held by The Nature Conservancy
- 2,101 acres of protected rural land that contains high quality longleaf pine forests and bottomland hardwoods
- \$516,469 in Greenbelt funds awarded
- \$1,632,531 in funds matched

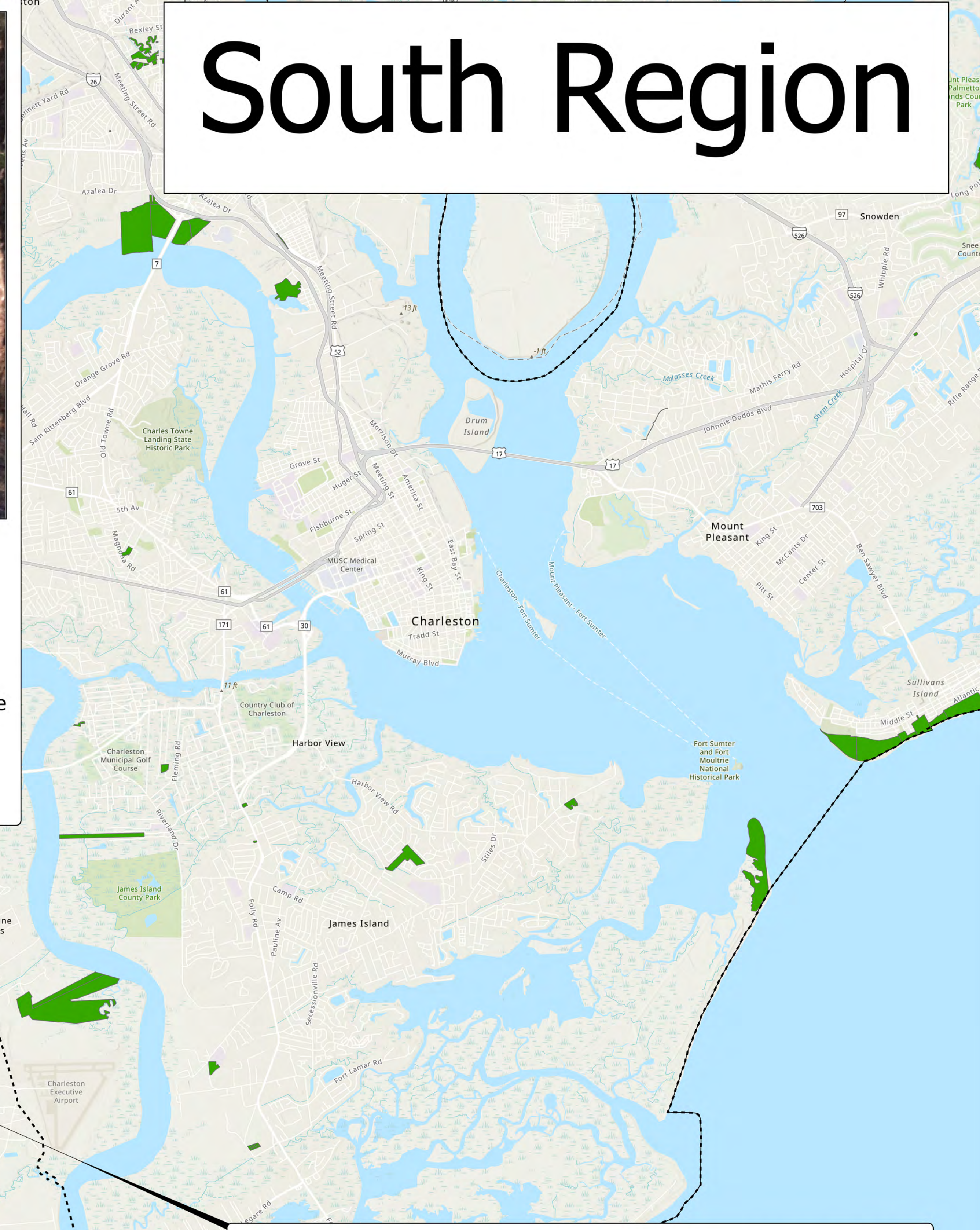


### Passive Greenspace

#### Wadmalaw Island Community Park

- Public Greenspace
- Acquired by Wadmalaw Island Citizens Improvement Committee
- 6.25 acres located adjacent to the Community Center offering passive outdoor recreational activities
- \$43,800 in Greenbelt funds awarded
- \$8,500 in funds matched

# South Region



### Heritage Landscapes

#### Angel Oak Park Expansion

- Public Greenspace.
- Acquired by Lowcountry Land Trust & City of Charleston.
- Total of 42.19 acres to protect and expand the current park with a welcome center, nature play area for kids, boardwalks, and interpretive trails.
- \$5,488,000 in Greenbelt funds awarded.
- \$2,114,000 in funds matched.



### Passive Greenspace

#### Botany Bay Preserve Expansion

- Public Greenspace
- Acquired by Open Space Institute Land Trust and donated to SC Department of Natural Resources
- 180 acres to expand the preserve and provide additional access for passive recreation and hunting opportunities
- \$2,027,030 in Greenbelt funds awarded
- \$1,200,00 in funds matched
